Bursting at the Seams

The Humane Society of Parkersburg (HSOP) is a private not-for-profit 501(c)3 corporation that contracts with local governmental authorities to provide services they are mandated to provide under the West Virginia Code.

As a privately owned and operated shelter, the Humane Society of Parkersburg has no affiliation with The Humane World for Animals (formerly the Humane Society of the United States) and is independently operated by an Executive Director who reports to the Board of Directors. While both the local and national organizations have similar goals and missions, the HSOP sets forth its own policies and procedures.

Those of you who follow our Facebook page (HSOP Community Page) have seen our plea for fosters and adoptions over the past few weeks. The reason we continue to make this plea so often is that we have been experiencing a phenomenon, since early 2022, where the number of intakes is exceeding the number of adoptions. This trend is, unfortunately, happening to most shelters across the country.

To further explain this concept, since July 1, 2024, we had 2,689 animals arrive at the shelter. Of the total received, we have adopted out 2,000 animals, reunited 300 animals with their owner and transferred 200 animals out to our rescue partners. Even with these efforts that still leaves us with 189 more animals in our care, not including the animals that were in foster or at the shelter on July 1.

If you are unable to adopt, we would urge you to consider fostering. This is a fantastic way to help make space at the shelter for animals that may be coming in as strays until their owner has a chance to reclaim them when you are unable to make a lifetime commitment to another animal. Fostering gives everyone a chance to see how the animal may act in a home environment instead of a kennel. It can allow them to interact with other pets and even children-all of which are invaluable in helping to find a permanent home for the animal.
