# The Kittens are Coming, The Kittens are Coming. . .

Here at the Humane Society this is a reality. We have gone from having 33 cats and kittens in foster on March 31 of this year to having 182 cats and kittens in foster as of this writing. That is an increase of more than 80% in the past two months.

In animal welfare, it seems one of the common ways used to mark passage of time is "Kitten Season", while the actual dates may vary based on the weather, you can rest assured that from the time it starts getting warm in the late winter and early spring until it begins to get cold in the fall there will be kittens.

This kitten season is brought about due to the number of cats in every community that are not spayed or neutered, thus multiple litters are born. The solution to the kitten problem is to be proactive and spay or neuter your cats, and even those cats that are not owned by any one individual, but roam through your neighborhood.

Free-roaming and feral or community cats live in our communities and make their homes wherever they can find food and shelter. There are ways to protect both the cats' lives and the personal property of others. It requires compromise and willingness to work toward a common goal to be able to solve the issues related to these cats.

The most effective way of solving this kitten problem is TNVR or Trap, Neuter, Vaccinate, and Return. This process has been found to be extremely effective in reducing the cat population as well as reducing many of the behaviors that cause individuals to become frustrated with the cats within their neighborhood. TNVR consists of trapping the cat(s) utilizing humane traps in order to have them altered and vaccinated and then returned to their community to live out their lives. The tip of the cat's left is removed as a universal sign that the cat has, in fact, been altered.

In addition to helping reduce the population concerns, TNVR also helps to eliminate many of the "bad" behaviors that cause nuisance. Being neutered is often the solution to male cats spraying or marking their territory and fighting with one another; a spayed female looking for a mate and is less likely to cause noise concerns.

Humane Society of Parkersburg will be providing additional information on TNVR in the coming weeks with the hope that we can continue to work together to reduce the pet overpopulation while improving the lives of those animals within our community.
